Assistance Program (GSEAP) Candidate Projects

This discussion paper presents the guidelines for the GMA's GSEAP program to facilitate discussion of potential candidate projects related to the Las Posas basins. Please forward any comments to Henry Graumlich at hgraumlich@calleguas.com.

I. Program Guidelines

- A. Each Project be completed within four years, with a potential one year extension with Board approval;
- B. Each Project be funded up to a maximum of \$250,000 with \$1 to \$1 matching funds;
- C. The total amount available for each Fiscal Year is \$500,000 (subject to funding or revision by the Board each year); and
- D. Applications are due November 30 of each year for funds available in the following fiscal year (July 1).

II. Application Submittal

- A. Name of Applicant and Project;
- B. Total Cost of Project, and amount of any Matching Funds;
- C. Project Schedule;
- D. Project Tasks and Milestones;
- E. Institutional Capacity, Resources, and Staffing for the Project;
- F. How a Proposal/Project meets the FCGMA's GSEAP criteria;
- G. CEQA Compliance (if applicable); and
- H. Any specific requests by staff.

III. General GSEAP Eligibility and Ranking Criteria

- A. Consistent with Agency's Goal of Achieving Safe Yield, GMA's Groundwater Management Plan, and Meeting the Basin Management Objectives
- B. Enhanced Water Supply and Quality, and/or Water Conservation Focus
- C. Region-wide/Integrated Water Resources Benefit
- D. Geographic Nexus to a Critical Overdrafted Area
- E. Leveraging Value of Funds
- F. Institutional Stability and Capacity to Complete Project
