



**Calleguas Municipal Water District is seeking candidates
for the position of Associate Project Manager, Project Manager, or Senior Project Manager**

Under general supervision and direction of the Manager of Engineering, the Associate Project Manager/Project Manager/Senior Project Manager has full responsibility for planning, design, and construction of capital construction projects, including large diameter pipelines, pump stations, reservoirs and water treatment plants, with a focus on projects with a significant electrical, instrumentation, and control systems component. Manages the work of design consultants, right of way agents, surveyors, other consultants, and contractors. Interfaces and negotiates with professional, technical, permitting, and managerial personnel of other organizations and agencies to identify necessary or potential projects; plan new facilities and improvements to existing facilities; develop plans and specifications; obtain permits; comply with environmental and safety regulations; acquire property; construct new facilities and improvements to existing facilities; resolve construction claims and other construction-related issues; solve problems; and negotiate agreements.

The minimum education and experience requirements are:

- A Bachelor's Degree in Civil, Mechanical, Control Systems, or Electrical Engineering or a related field.
- Associate Project Manager: 2 years of professional engineering experience in design and construction of water and/or electrical and control system facilities and a California Engineer-in-Training Certificate.
- Project Manager: 7 to 10 years of progressively responsible professional engineering experience in design and construction of water and/or electrical and control system facilities and California registration as a Professional Engineer.
- Senior Project Manager: More than 10 years of progressively responsible professional engineering experience in design and construction of water and/or electrical and control system facilities and California registration as a Professional Engineer.

The annual salary is \$90,900.00 to \$121,200.00 for Associate Project Manager, \$108,748.56 \$144,998.16 for Project Manager, and \$122,310.72 to \$163,080.72 for Senior Project Manager. The District contributes up to \$2,719.70 per month toward the cost of premiums for medical insurance for employees and their dependents. The District pays premium for dental insurance, vision insurance and EAP program membership for employees and their dependents. The district pays for a \$100,000 life insurance policy for each employee. The District contracts with CalPERS for 2% @ 55 or 2% @ 62

formula depending on whether you are a New or Classic member as defined by the Public Employees' Pension Reform Act (PEPRA). The District pays the employer and employee contribution for Classic Members. New members (PEPRA) 6.75% of their salary rate as determined by CalPERS.
