Calleguas Municipal Water District is seeking candidates for the position of Senior Controls Technician

Under supervision of the Control Systems Supervisor, the Senior Controls Technician is an advanced journeyman position performing skilled electrical or control work in the Control Systems division. The position requires a proficient knowledge in electrical and control theory; the abilities to work unsupervised and effectively communicate; and display initiative, versatility and innovation in solving complex problems. Training will be provided as required. Typical duties include the installation, maintenance, repair, calibration, and testing on a variety of programmable logic controllers, process control interfaces, metering and monitoring equipment used in water distribution, water treatment, and power generation; testing and documentation of wiring, motors and electrical switchgear; maintenance of backup power systems; the maintenance and monitoring of cathodic protection systems; documentation of monthly water sales; and the programming and troubleshooting of PLC ladder logic.

The Senior Controls Technician must also possess or obtain SWRCB DDW Water Distribution Operator Grade 1 and Water Treatment Operator Grade 1 certificates within 18 months of hire.

Some of the minimum education and experience requirements are:

- Must have a thorough knowledge of electrical control, digital and analog electronic theory, and circuit analysis. In addition the individual must have a full range of electrical and/or PLC programming skills.
- Ability to add, subtract, multiply, and divide in all units of measure, using whole numbers, common fractions, and decimals.
- Ability to compute rate, ratio, and percent and to create and interpret bar graphs.
- Ability to read and interpret documents such as safety rules, operating and maintenance instructions, procedure manuals, and blue prints.
- Ability to write routine reports and internal memoranda.
- Ability to communicate effectively with employees and customers.
- Knowledge of safety requirements for working around heavy and power equipment, construction sites, high voltages, and in confined spaces.
- A high school diploma or general education degree (GED) or a minimum of two years related experience and/or training or equivalent combination of education and experience in the installation and maintenance of electrical equipment, instrumentation or control systems using equipment; such as, programmable logic controllers, power supplies, Fluke type test meters, calibrators, transmitters, multiplexers, and communication equipment using protocols such as rs232, rs485, and TCP/IP.

The annual salary range for Senior Controls Technician is \$80,250 to \$107,000.
