**NOTICE REGARDING SUSPENSION OF  
CAPITAL CONSTRUCTION CHARGES (Ordinance 14)**

At its regularly scheduled meeting last night, the Calleguas Municipal Water District Board of Directors voted to temporarily suspend collections of the Capital Construction Charge (CCC) enacted under Ordinance No. 14 pending determination of continuing the suspension indefinitely at its regularly scheduled meeting on December 7, 2016.

Among other things, current purveyor demand projections, anticipated state measures further emphasizing long-term water use efficiency, local land use policies restricting new development, and increased development of local water resources have effectively negated the need to increase system capacity in the foreseeable future. Planned capital projects will address water supply reliability and aging infrastructure rather than increased capacity to serve growth.

Please inform appropriate staff that effective today, District Proof(s) of Payment (receipts) for the Capital Construction Charge will not be required for issuance of either will-serve letters or building permits or for installation of new water meters. As such, the preparation of Statements of Meter Size is suspended and customers should not be referred to Calleguas for fee information.

Calleguas wishes to extend its thanks to your agency and staff for the many years of assistance and cooperation rendered to the benefit of the service area. Essential expansion of District facilities were made possible by Capital Construction Charges.

Further information will follow the December 7 Board meeting.
