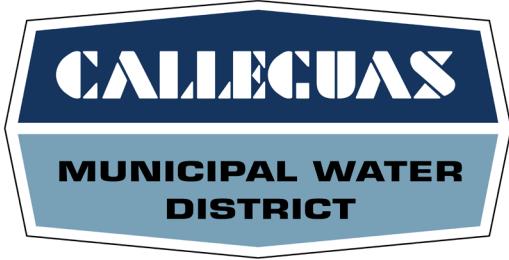

**Subject:** Item 6.C – Approve Professional Services by V&A Consulting Engineers, Inc. in the Amount of \$238,920 to Perform Pipeline Condition Assessment Services for Lindero Feeder No. 2

**Objective:** Provide safe, reliable, and cost-effective service by ensuring infrastructure reliability through proactive pipeline condition assessment.

**Recommended Action:** Approve professional services by V&A Consulting Engineers, Inc. (V&A) in the amount of \$238,920 to perform pipeline condition assessment services for Lindero Feeder No. 2.

**Budget Impact:** No impact. Costs were included in the budget for the 2025-26 fiscal year.

**Discussion:**

After experiencing several failures of its pre-stressed cylinder pipelines (PCCP), the District has been actively assessing and rehabilitating its PCCP since 1999. With advancements in inspection technologies, the District has expanded its pipeline condition assessments to include the District's other pipeline materials, which are primarily welded steel pipe (WSP) and concrete cylinder pipe (CCP, also known as bar-wrapped pipe). This is a cost-effective approach to reducing the risk of failure and associated disruption and damage.

In 2021, HDR prepared a Pipeline Condition Assessment Planning Study to identify the methods and technologies to perform pipeline condition assessment of Calleguas's WSP and CCP. In 2023, based on the recommendations in this study, staff contracted V&A to test the new

approach for pipeline condition assessment on a section of the CCP Oxnard-Santa Rosa Feeder, Units 1 and 2.

After the successful completion of the CCP Oxnard-Santa Rosa Feeder Units 1 and 2 condition assessment, staff identified the CCP Lindero Feeder No.2 for the next condition assessment. This pipeline was selected due to its construction type, age, and importance to the District's objective to provide reliable service. Lindero Feeder No. 2 is the sole pipeline for conveying water from the newly constructed Calleguas-Las Virgenes Interconnection Pump Station to the Conejo Valley Feeder.

The pipeline condition assessment includes the following tasks:

- Electrical Continuity Survey – This verifies whether the pipeline is electrically connected (bonded at joints), which is essential to the viability of cathodic protection for a pipeline. It also helps determine the most appropriate method of conducting additional corrosion surveys and aids in understanding the survey results.
- Cell-to-Cell Potential Survey – Corrosion of metals produces electrical currents and differences in electrical potential (voltage). A potential survey collects voltage readings to identify hot spots where corrosion may be occurring.
- Pipe-to-Soil Potential Survey – Similar to cell-to-cell potential surveys, this type of survey collects potential readings but it provides direct measurements of corrosion activity on the pipeline. This method requires the pipeline to be electrically continuous. If the pipeline is not electrically continuous, the survey will still provide valuable information as the portions of the pipe that are surveyed can be used to estimate the condition of the entire pipeline and understand how the pipeline is performing in its environment.
- Leak Detection – Leak detection will be accomplished by conveying a tool through the interior of the pipeline while it is flowing. Small undetected leaks can grow to larger leaks that can potentially lead to catastrophic failure. Locating leaks before they result in large pipeline failures saves both money and water.

V&A has relevant experience, expertise, and familiarity with the District's facilities. Their work continues to be of good quality and the cost for professional services is reasonable for the work required.

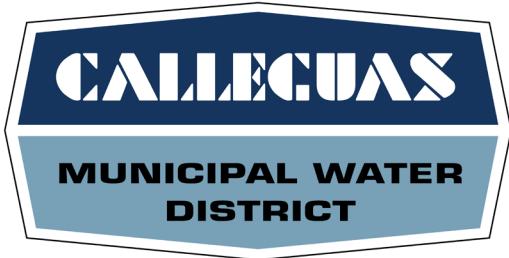

**Objective:** Provide regional and statewide leadership by nominating a Calleguas Director for the Association of California Water Agencies Joint Powers Insurance Authority California Water Insurance Fund.

**Recommended Action:** Adopt Resolution No. 2121, A Resolution of the Board of Directors of Calleguas Municipal Water District Nominating its ACWA JPIA Board Member to the California Water Insurance Fund Board.

**Budget Impact:** None.

**Discussion:**

Approximately seven years ago, the Association of California Water Agencies (ACWA) Joint Powers Insurance Authority (JPIA) established a captive insurance company called the California Water Insurance Fund (CWIF). The CWIF is a wholly-owned private insurance company organized in Utah and was formed to save members money through discounted excess and reinsurance costs, higher investment earnings, and a wider variety of risk financing options. CWIF is owned by ACWA JPIA, has its own Board of Directors, and is managed by ACWA JPIA staff.

There are two positions to be filled on the CWIF Board of Directors. An election will be held during the ACWA JPIA Board of Directors' meeting at the spring conference in Sacramento. These two positions will be filled for two years each.

Director Quady has done an excellent job representing District interests on the ACWA JPIA Board of Directors for the past 14 years and previously served on the CWIF Board of Directors from 2019-2024. Candidates must be nominated via resolution by their own agency and need to receive concurring resolutions from three other ACWA JPIA members.

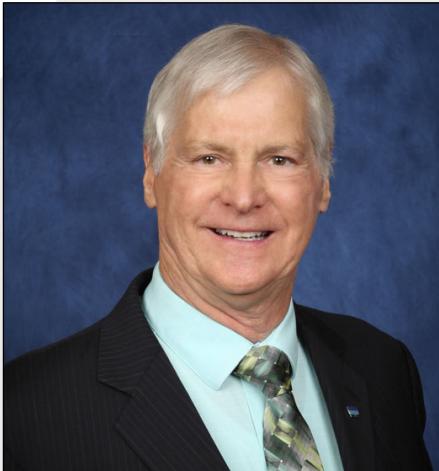

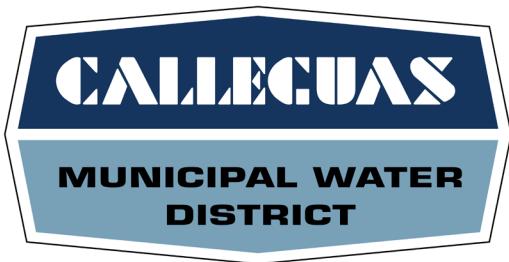

**Subject:** Item 7.B – Discussion Regarding Resolution No. 2122, A Resolution of the Board of Directors of Calleguas Municipal Water District Honoring Congresswoman Julia Brownley for Leadership and Support of Regional Water Reliability

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**Objective:** Recognize and formally express appreciation for Congresswoman Julia Brownley's leadership, partnership with the District, and advocacy in securing federal funding that advances regional water reliability.

**Recommended Action:** Approve Resolution No. 2122, A Resolution of the Board of Directors of Calleguas Municipal Water District Honoring Congresswoman Julia Brownley's Leadership, Partnership with the District, and Advocacy in Securing Federal Funding that Advances Regional Water Reliability.

**Budget Impact:** Offsets \$1.092 million from the anticipated approximate \$12 million cost for the Lake Bard Pump Station portion of the Lake Bard Pump Station, LBWFP Flowmeter, and Lake Bard Outlet Tower Improvements (Project No. 587).

**Discussion:** Congresswoman Julia Brownley has demonstrated strong leadership and continued commitment to infrastructure investment and water reliability for Ventura County and the broader region. In 2024, the Congresswoman included the Lake Bard Pump Station in her Community Project Funding request. Through two years of federal funding uncertainty and

deferrals, the Congresswoman persisted, retaining the project in her request and championing its need until, with the passage of H.R. 6938 last month, the \$1.092 million was secured.

The Lake Bard Pump Station would significantly enhance the effectiveness of Calleguas's existing outage water supply. Currently, hydraulic constraints limit Calleguas's ability to fully treat all of the 10,500 acre-feet stored in Lake Bard. Only approximately 7,500 acre-feet can be treated; the remaining water can only be disinfected, which would require issuance of a boil water notice if delivered to customers. The Lake Bard Pump Station would remove these constraints, allowing nearly all water stored in Lake Bard to be fully treated and safely delivered. This improvement would increase available outage potable water supplies by nearly 30 percent, strengthening regional resilience and ensuring greater reliability.

The Lake Bard Pump Station supports the delivery of reliable water supplies to Calleguas's 19 purveyors and the communities they serve. Federal participation in this project reflects the importance of sustained partnerships between local water providers and elected officials in addressing long-term water reliability challenges.

This resolution is intended to formally acknowledge Congresswoman Brownley's advocacy and leadership and to convey Calleguas's sincere appreciation for her efforts to support critical water infrastructure investments that benefit the region.

**WHEREAS**, Calleguas Municipal Water District provides wholesale water supplies to 19 purveyors, a service area that support approximately 650,000 residents — three quarters of Ventura County's population — and the associated agriculture, manufacturing, small businesses, restaurants, and essential services; and

**WHEREAS**, Calleguas imports water from the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California through a single tunnel connection located in the seismically active Santa Susana Mountains, representing a known vulnerability in the regional water supply system; and

**WHEREAS**, Lake Bard and the Lake Bard Water Filtration Plant (LBWFP) provide a critical outage water supply that can be used to serve the Calleguas service area in the event of imported water supply interruption caused by earthquake, infrastructure failure, or other causes; and

**WHEREAS**, currently, hydraulic constraints limit Calleguas's ability to fully treat the entire 10,500 acre-feet stored in Lake Bard; and

**WHEREAS**, the Lake Bard Pump Station would remove these constraints, allowing nearly all water stored in Lake Bard to be fully treated and safely delivered, increasing available outage potable water supplies by nearly 30 percent, strengthening regional resilience and ensuring greater reliability; and

**WHEREAS**, Congresswoman Julia Brownley demonstrated strong leadership and a continued commitment to infrastructure investment, water reliability for Ventura County and the broader region, and public safety by championing the project through two years of federal funding uncertainty and deferrals, culminating in the passage of H.R. 6938, which provides \$1.092 million in federal funding for the Lake Bard Pump Station portion of the Lake Bard Pump Station, LBWFP Flowmeter, and Lake Bard Outlet Tower Improvements (Project No. 587); and

**WHEREAS**, this federal investment reflects the importance of partnerships between local water providers and elected officials in advancing critical infrastructure projects that protect public health and ensure reliable water supplies for the region;

Now, therefore, be it **RESOLVED**, that the Board of Directors of Calleguas Municipal Water District hereby expresses its sincere appreciation and gratitude to Congresswoman Julia Brownley for her leadership and partnership with the District, and advocacy in securing federal funding for the Lake Bard Pump Station that advances regional water reliability.

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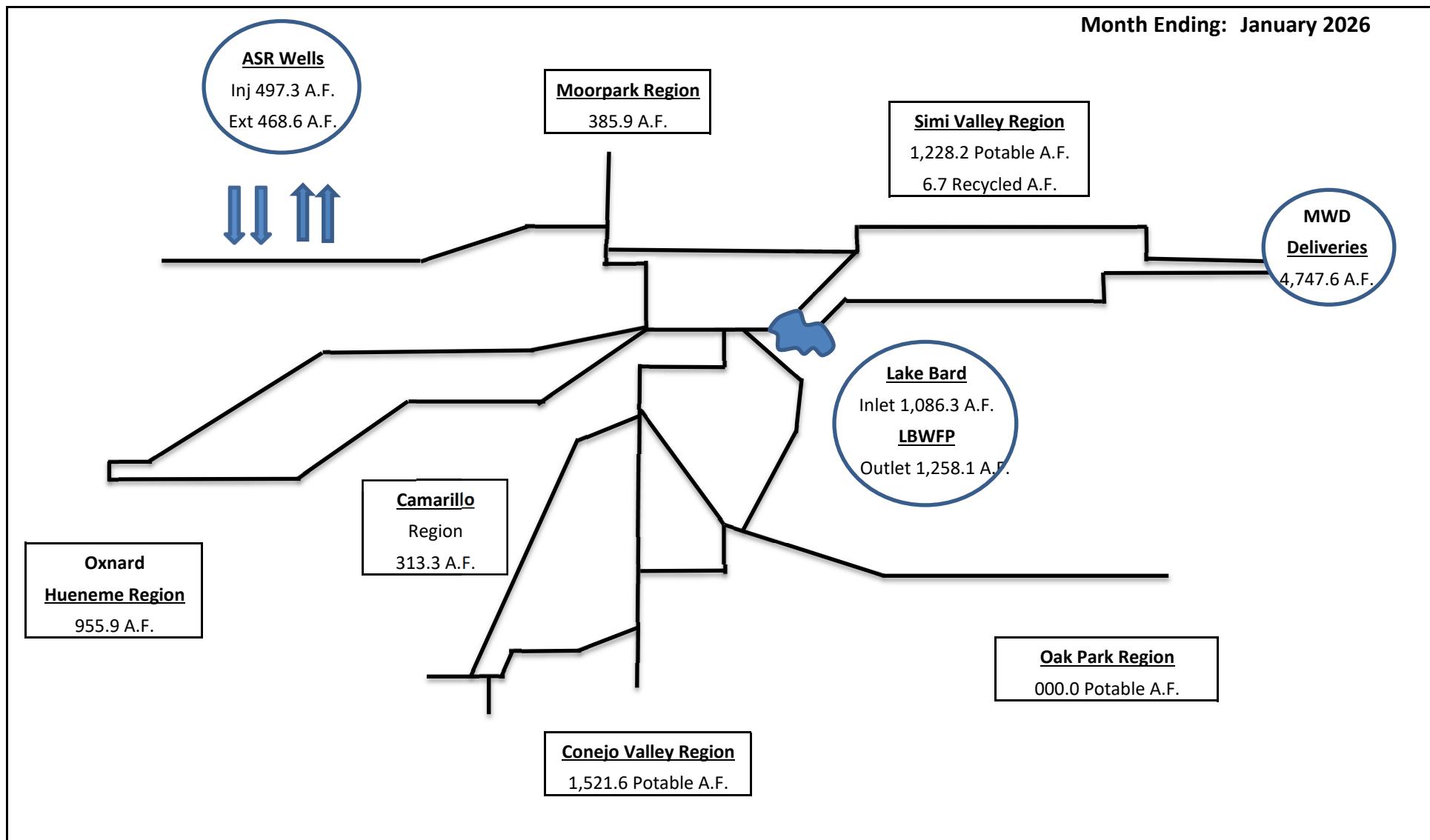

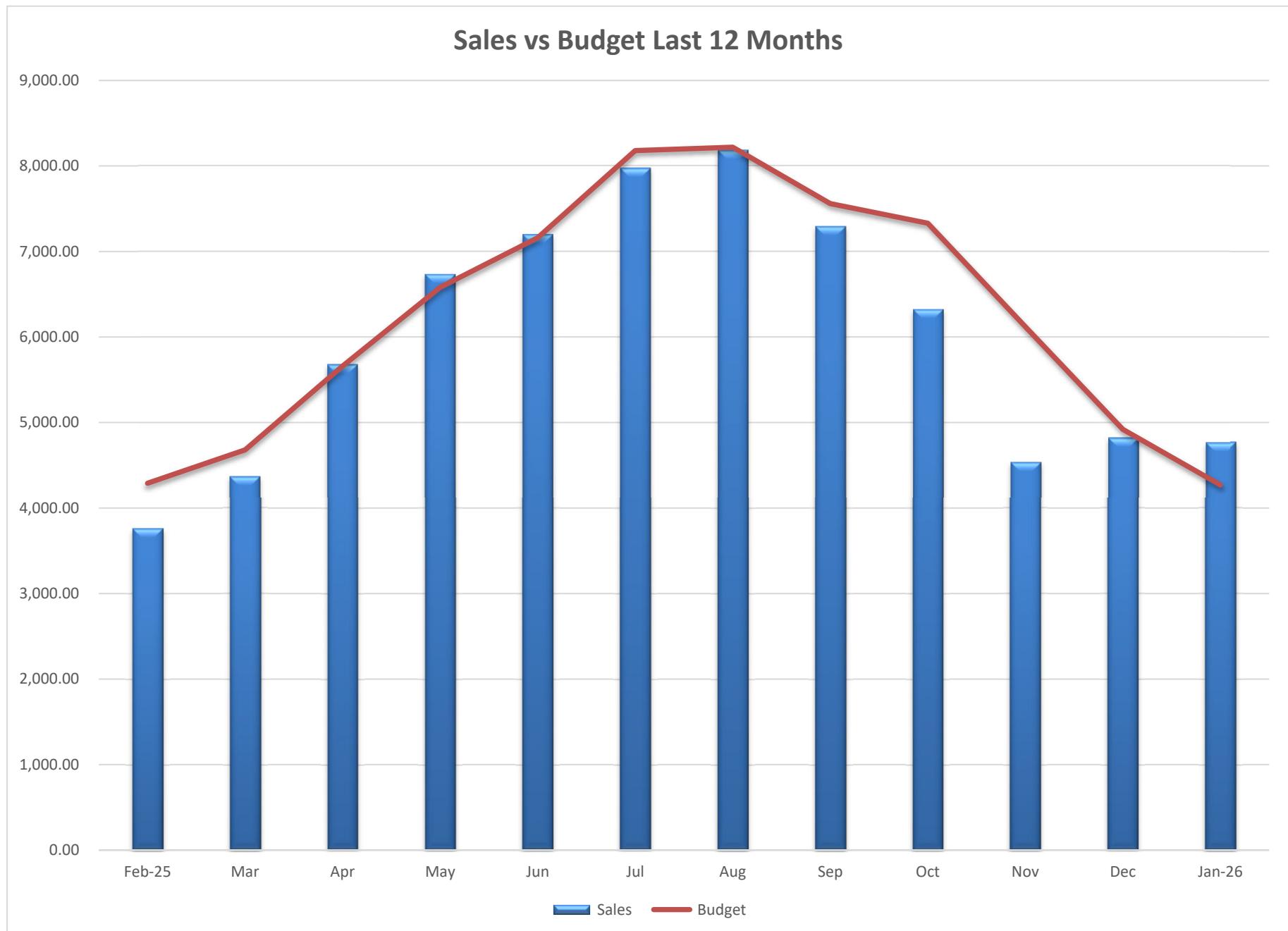
